



Saturday Course Offerings!

The College Now office of Queensborough Community College will be offering **three** different credited courses in three different disciplines for the Spring 2017 semester for **FREE**- [MA-119](#), [CIS-101](#), and [MT-111](#). The descriptions for each are as follows:

- **MA-119 College Algebra**

3 class hours 3 credits

**CUNY Placement testing recommended prior to enrollment*

Prerequisite: A score of 80 or higher on the New York State Regents examinations (70 or higher on the common core) in Integrated Algebra, or Geometry, or Algebra 2 & Trigonometry, and by successfully completing each course in the three-course Regents sequence: Integrated Algebra,;Geometry; and Algebra 2 & Trigonometry

A basic presentation of the fundamental concepts of college algebra, systems of linear equations, inequalities, linear, quadratic exponential and logarithmic functions.

- **CIS-101 Introduction to Microcomputer Applications**

2 class hours 3 credits

Introduction to the use of computers in business, concepts of computer hardware and software, elements of problem-solving. Designed to provide “hands-on” experience with the IBM personal computer. Software packages are applied to business applications including spreadsheets, word processing, data base and graphics.

- **MT-111 Technical Graphics**

2 class hours 2 laboratory hours 2 credits

Prerequisite: Permission of the Department

Introduction to technical presentation; plan elevation, section, detail, perspective, and model making. Development of preliminary working drawings. Understanding of basic architectural design concepts.

If you will be entering as a junior or senior in high school during the Spring 2017 semester, these courses could be a great opportunity for you to earn college credit before even stepping foot on a college campus! You will be saving yourself time and money and ultimately bring yourself closer to graduating college!

These courses will begin [Saturday, January 28th at 9:00am](#) and take place each consecutive Saturday for the duration of the semester. Attendance for each of the classes is mandatory.
